

RESOLUTION 2026-7

A RESOLUTION, AMENDING RESOLUTION 2025-3, ESTABLISHING THAT THE NEWTON WAYNE FIRE COMPANY WILL NO LONGER REIMBURSE WAYNE TOWNSHIP FOR THE COMMISSION AND ASSOCIATED PAYROLL TAXES FOR THE COLLECTION OF THE FIRE TAX.

RESOLVED, the Supervisors of Wayne Township, Mifflin County, Pennsylvania, at a regularly advertised meeting, do hereby enact the following:

The commission and accompanying payroll taxes set forth by Resolution 2025-3 reimbursing Wayne Township by the Newton Wayne Fire Company for the collection of the Fire Tax is hereby rescinded. The 9% commission rate and all payroll taxes associated with the collection of the Fire Tax will be paid by Wayne Township out of the Wayne Township Payroll Account. Also, all collection fees for the 2025 Fire Tax Collection Year paid to the Wayne Township Tax Collector will be refunded to the Newton Wayne Fire Company by Wayne Township.

All other provisions of Resolution 2025-3 remain as resolved and enacted on January 6, 2025, consistent with Section 36.1 of Act Number 394 Local Tax Collector Law of May 25, 1945. The Resolution shall be effective immediately.

Resolved and enacted this 2nd day of February, 2026.


