On June 1, 2026, the Wayne Township Board of Supervisors met for their regular monthly meeting at 7:00 P.M. The meeting was held at the Country Crossroads Community Center, 3055 Ferguson Valley Road, McVeytown, PA. Members of the Board present were Chuck Miles, Chairman, Don Gearhart, Vice Chairman, and Ted Reed, Supervisor. Ten residents and visitors were also present.

Chairman Chuck Miles called the meeting to order and led in the Pledge Allegiance to the Flag.

Don made the motion to approve the minutes; Ted seconded the motion; all in favor, motion carried.

Ted gave the treasures report.

Chuck opened the floor for public comment on the agenda and reminded those present that each speaker will have five minutes to comment and must be a resident or tax payer in Wayne Township.

Dan Walker, resident, spoke from the podium and made comment about the new tile being installed on Rhone Road. No other comments concerning the agenda were received.

John Flicker. Wright Land Surveying presented the Margaret S. Jacka Irrevocable Trust Subdivision. Ted moved to accept the Subdivision according to the Mifflin County Planning Commissions comments; Chuck seconded the motion; all in favor, motion carried.

Don made the motion to advertise for the 2026/2027 aggregates and fuel contracts; Ted seconded the motion; all in favor, motion carried.

Don made the motion to give permission for the September 11th Memorial Trail Signage to be placed in the Township; Chuck seconded the motion; all in favor, motion carried.

Ted made the motion to permit Keller Engineers to do road surveys to put weight limits on designated Township roads; Chuck seconded the motion; all in favor, motion carried.

Ted made the motion to advertise for bids to install the tile on Rhone Road; Don seconded the motion; all in favor, motion carried. Note: EADS Engineering ran the ad in the Lewistown Sentinel.

Chuck made the motion to open a Kish Bank Account to deposit the Wayne Township Fire Tax proceeds into at the Township Auditors request. Theodore Reed, Donald Gearhart and Ralph Miles will be authorized signers on the Fire Tax Account. Two signatures will be required for a valid check.

Jeff Hoover, Recreation Board Chairman, gave the Recreation Advisory Board update and thanked Pam Sechrist and the community for their help cleaning up along the roads. Jeff updated the residents on the recent Community Yard Sale and the upcoming Trunk or Treat, Christmas Party, America 250 picnic, Flags for heroes and the need for more volunteers for the picnic.

Chuck opened the floor to public comment and reminded the residents present that they will have 3 minutes in which to speak and they can comment on any subject relating to the Township.

Dwight Aurand commented from the podium about the road scarring on Mount hope Road. It was explained that the scarring was done by one of the Stoltzfus's and has been addressed.

Don made the motion to pay the bills; Ted seconded the motion; all in favor, motion carried.

Don made the motion to adjourn the meeting; Ted seconded the motion; all in favor, motion carried. The meeting adjourned at 7:47 P.M.
